Why do we not observe the Sabbath day like they did in the Old Testament?



PURPOSE OF THE SABBATH

1.Commanded in the 10 commandments.

2.Israel's Deliverance from Egypt 3. It was the day at the end of creation.



Sabbath...from Sabat...means to rest or cease from work.
When God "rested" on the 7th day...it wasn't because He was tired...but it was because EVERYTHING WAS DONE!



Matthew 28.1-4...Christ rose on the first day of the week.

Acts 20.7 Now on the first day of the week, when the disciples came together to break bread, Paul, ready to depart the next day, spoke to them and continued his message until midnight.



I Cor 16.1-2 Now concerning the collection for the saints, as I have given orders to the churches of Galatia, so you must do also: On the first day of the week let each one of you lay something aside, storing up as he may prosper, that there be no collections when I come.



We need to remember that the purpose of the Law was not a set of rules and ceremonies to become right with God.
