The prayer of a righteous person is powerful and effective. James 5:16b (NIV)

> Prayer is... Intimate communication with God.

Three Important Questions:

1. WHO should pray?

The prayer of a righteous person is powerful and effective. ¹⁷ Elijah was a human being, even as we are. He prayed earnestly that it would not rain, and it did not rain on the land for three and a half years. ¹⁸ Again he prayed, and the heavens gave rain, and the earth produced its crops. **James 5:16b-18 (NIV)**

Ahab told his wife Jezebel what Elijah had done and that he had killed the prophets. ² She sent a message to Elijah: "You killed my prophets. Now I'm going to kill you! I pray that the gods will punish me even more severely if I don't do it by this time tomorrow." **1 Kings 19:1-2 (CEV)**

³ Elijah was afraid when he got her message, and he ran to the town of Beersheba in Judah. He left his servant there, ⁴ then walked another whole day into the desert. Finally, he came to a large bush and sat down in its shade. He begged the Lord, "I've had enough. Just let me die!" **1 Kings 19:3-4a (CEV)**

2. HOW should we pray?

We must ASK.

You do not have because you do not ask God. James 4:2c (NIV)

• We must ask with the right MOTIVE.

When you ask, you do not receive, because you ask with wrong motives, that you may spend what you get on your pleasures. **James 4:3 (NIV)**

• We must strive to live a clean LIFE.

If I had ignored my sins, the Lord would not have listened to me. ¹⁹ But God has indeed heard me; He has listened to my prayer. **Psalm 66:18-19 (GNT)**

- We must ask in FAITH.

But when you ask, you must believe and not doubt, because the one who doubts is like a wave of the sea, blown and tossed by the wind. ⁷ That person should not expect to receive anything from the Lord. **James 1:6-7 (NIV)**

3. WHEN Should I Pray?

Is anyone among you suffering? Then he must pray. Is anyone cheerful? He is to sing praises. ¹⁴ Is anyone among you sick? Then he must call for the elders of the church and they are to pray over him, anointing him with oil in the name of the Lord; ¹⁵ and the prayer of faith will restore the one who is sick, and the Lord will raise him up, and if he has committed sins, they will be forgiven him. ¹⁶ Therefore, confess your sins to one another, and pray for one another so that you may be healed. **James 5:13-16a (NASB)**
