- The average American has 7 to 8 credit cards in their wallet or purse.

- More than 1.5 million people are filing for personal bankruptcy every year.
 (USA Today)
- The average U.S. household with student debt owes \$58, 957. (Nerd Wallet)
- 27 percent of Black households are late on paying their debts, compared to 15 percent of White households. (Demos.org)
- 48% of Blacks have bad credit compared to 27% of Whites and 34% of Hispanics. (Fannie Mae)

The wife of a man from the company of the prophets <u>cried out to Elisha</u>, "Your servant my husband is dead, and you know that he revered the LORD. But now his creditor is coming to take my two boys as his slaves." 2 Kings 4:1 (NIV)
