## Black Wealth, White Wealth Stats:

- The average Black family passes on zero net financial assets to future generations. (Black Enterprise Magazine)
- In 2019, the median wealth of Black households was \$24,100, compared to \$189,100 for White households. Therefore, the typical Black household had 12.7% of the wealth of the typical White household, and they owned \$165,000 less in wealth. (American Progress.org)
- One in three white households will receive a substantial inheritance during their lifetime compared to only one in ten black households. (Economists Robert Avery and Michael Rendall)
- An inheritance increases wealth by more than \$100,000 for white families and only \$4,000 for black families.
