#### Bad Theology of Happiness:

- Whatever makes me happy must be right. Whatever makes me unhappy must be wrong.
- Discomfort, delay, risk, failure, suffering, inconvenience, and obstacles can't be God's will.
- God exists to make me happy.

### Difference between being Happy and being Joyful?

- Happiness is External. Joy is Internal.
- Happiness depends on outward circumstances. Joy depends on inward character.
- Happiness meets surface needs. Joy meets your deepest needs.
- Happiness evaporates and disappears in times of suffering. Joy intensifies in times of suffering.
- Happiness is based on chance. Joy is based on choice.
- Happiness depends upon what happens to you. Joy depends upon who lives within you.

# **1** Thessalonians **5:16-17** (NLT): Always be joyful. Never stop praying.



Do not be anxious about anything, but in every situation, by prayer and petition, with thanksgiving, present your requests to God. And the peace of God, which transcends all understanding, will guard your hearts and your minds in Christ Jesus. Philippians 4:6-7 (NIV)

Prayer means: Communicating with God

Petition means: To ask or beg for something you need earnestly or humbly.

Thanksgiving means: Gratitude directed towards God.
