Taming your tongue isn't about your ability to control what you say — Taming your tongue is about being filled with and led by the Holy Spirit!

Three Things you need to know to Tame Your Tongue:

Be Aware of the Tongue's Power!

"Now if we put bits into the mouths of horses so that they obey us, we direct their whole bodies. And consider ships: Though very large and driven by fierce winds, they are guided by a very small rudder wherever the will of the pilot directs. 2. Be Aware of the Tongue's **Potential** and **Poison!**

"Every kind of animal, bird, reptile, and fish is tamed and has been tamed by humankind. But no one can tame the tongue. It is a restless evil, full of deadly poison."

James 3:7-8 CSB

Be Aware of the Tongue's Paradox!

"With the tongue, we bless our God and Father, and with it we curse people who are made in God's likeness. Blessing and cursing come out of the same mouth. My brothers and sisters, these things should not be this way. Does a spring pour out sweet and bitter water from the same opening? Can a fig tree produce olives, my brothers and sisters, or a grapevine produce figs? Neither can a saltwater spring yield fresh water."

James 3:9-12 CSB

What comes out of your mouth is what is in your heart.

- 1. Submit your heart, mind, and tongue to the Lord daily. Matthew 16:24-26
- 2. Seek the Holy Spirit to heighten the awareness of your words. John 14:26

- 4. **Start** the process of forgiveness for any unloving words or attitudes. Matthew 6:14-15
- 5. Speak words that will encourage, comfort, edify, and inspire. Philippians 2:1-5
