It Begins with DESIRE

It Leads to DECEPTION

"...but each person is tempted when they are dragged away by their own evil desire and enticed." James 1:14 (NIV)

Results in DISOBEDIENCE

"Then, after desire has conceived, it gives birth to sin." James 1:15a (NIV)

It Ends in DEATH

"...and sin, when it is full-grown, gives birth to death." James 1:15b (NIV)

3. Don't be deceived by temptation, **<u>REJECT IT</u>**.

Don't be deceived, my dear brothers and sisters. James 1:16 (NIV)
