1. Don't settle in search of
"Terah took his son Abram, his grandson Lot son of Haran, and his daughter-in-law Sarai, the wife of his son Abram, and together they set out from Ur of the Chaldeans to go to Canaan. But when they came to Haran, they settled there. Terah lived 205 years, and he died in Haran" Genesis 11:31-32 (NIV)
2. Be willing to forsake the
"The LORD had said to Abram, 'Leave your country, your people and your father's household and go to the land I will show you."
Genesis 12:1 (NIV)
3. Remain ready for
"When Barnabas and Saul had finished their mission, they returned from Jerusalem, taking with them John, also called Mark." Acts 12:25 (NIV)
"In the church at Antioch there were prophets and teachersWhile they were worshiping the Lord and fasting, the Holy Spirit said, 'Set apart for me Barnabas and Saul for the work to which I have called them.'
