

INTRODUCTION

- PRAISING GOD FOR HOW HE DEALS WITH AN ENEMY 1-9
- 1. Singing Praises To The God Who Does Great Things 1-2
- a. I will praise You, O LORD, with my whole heart
- b. I will tell of all Your marvelous works
- c. I will be glad and rejoice in You
- d. I will sing praise to Your name, O Most High

2. David Praises God For Defending Him Against His Enemies - 3-5

- a. When my enemies turn back, they shall fall and perish at Your presence
- b. For You have maintained my right and my cause
- c. You sat on the throne...You have rebuked the nations...You have blotted out their name forever and ever

3. David Celebrates The Lord's Victory - 6-8

- a. O enemy, destructions are finished forever
- b. But the LORD shall endure forever
- c. He shall administer judgment for the peoples in uprightness

PRAISING GOD FOR HOW HE TREATS THE OPPRESSED – 9-16

- 1. God Is A Trustworthy Refuge 9-10
- a. The LORD also will be a refuge for the oppressed:
- b. Those who know Your name will put their trust in You

2. Singing Praise To The God Who Remembers His People – 11-12

- a. Sing praises to the LORD
- b. When He avenges blood, He remembers them; He does not forget the cry of the humble

3. A Plea For Mercy From The God Who Remembers – 13-14

- a. Have mercy on me, O LORD
- b. That I may tell of all Your praise

4. The Destiny Of The Wicked – 15-16

- a. The nations have sunk down in the pit which they made
- b. The LORD is known by the judgment He executes

• APPEALING TO THE GOD WHO JUDGES IN RIGHTEOUSNESS - 17-20

- 1. God Will Deal With Both The Wicked And The Humble 17-18
- a. The wicked shall be turned into hell
- b. For the needy shall not always be forgotten

2. An Appeal For God To Glorify Himself Among The Nations – 19-20

- a. Arise, O LORD, do not let man prevail
- b. Let the nations be judged in Your sight...that the nations may know themselves to be but men
