RENEWING OUR PRIORITY TO WORSHIP

"worship" shows up 10x in John 4:20-24. Psalm 29:2, 95:6-7a

We go to church to worship God, and that's done by GIVING, not getting.

PREPARING OUR HEARTS FOR WORSHIP

Exodus 19

1. THE DEFINITION OF WORSHIP

What is worship?

WORSHIP is: "honor paid to a superior being"

"proskuneo" which means "to kiss toward, to kiss the hand, to bow down, to prostrate oneself."

Remember...

Your responsibility, by God's enabling, is to constantly apply the divine principles and truths you have heard (Phil. 2:12-13; 1 Tim. 4:7-9; Jam 1:22-27). As you meditate on this message, ask yourself these questions:

How does God want my beliefs/actions to change?

How can I accomplish this change?

What is the first step toward bringing about this change?

3. THE DISTINCTION OF WORSHIP

- Ministry is that which comes down to us from the Father, through the Son, in the power of the Holy Spirit, to one another in the form of spiritual gifts.
- Worship is that which goes up from us, by the power of the Holy Spirit, through the Son, to the Father.

5 STEPS TO PREPARE OUR HEARTS FOR WORSHIP

- 1. Quiet Your Mind
- 2. Pray in Humility
- 3. Praise Him
- 4. Be Still
- 5. Sing

1. COMMON MISCONCEPTIONS OF WORSHIP.

- ⇒ Worship Always Takes Place in Church.
- \Rightarrow Worship is an <u>Outward Expression</u>.
- \Rightarrow The People on the Platform are the <u>Focus</u>.

We need to take the premium off Performance and put it on PRAISE!

 \Rightarrow The People in the Pews are the <u>Audience</u>.

God is the audience!

Have you played your part today?
"Did I worship God today in spirit and truth?"

2. LIBERATING LESSONS OF WORSHIP.

 \Rightarrow Worship is always <u>Active</u> never <u>Passive</u>. Gen.35:2, Ex.24:7, 2 Chron.5:11-14, Neh. 8:6

⇒ Worship is the <u>Central Activity</u> of the Church. Acts 2:46-47, Eph.5:19
⇒ Worship is the Source of <u>Spiritual Renewal</u> . Worship is like A NUTRITIOUS MEAL. Acts 4:13 "they realized that they had been with Jesus."
⇒ Worship is the Greatest Investment We Can Make. "Therefore by Him let us continually offer the sacrifice of praise to God, that is, the fruit of our lips, giving thanks to His name." Hebrews13:15
⇒ Worship Brings <u>Healing</u> to the Soul. David said in the 23 rd Psalm, <i>"He restores my soul."</i>
⇒ <u>Public</u> Worship is either Enhanced or Hindered by our <u>Private</u> Worship.
\Rightarrow Worship is Liberated by the Study of <u>Scripture</u> .
