**II. THE PROMOTION OF ERROR - 1 Timothy 4:2–3 -** *“through the insincerity of liars whose consciences are seared, who forbid marriage and require abstinence from foods that God created...”*

**A. Their Deceptive Speech -** *“through the insincerity of liars...”*

**B. Their Damaged Conscience -** *“whose consciences are seared...”*

**C. Their Distorted Religion -** *“who forbid marriage and require abstinence from foods...”*

Legalism says: *“Jesus is not enough—you must also keep our rules.”*  
The gospel says: *“Christ is sufficient.”*

**III. THE PROTECTION OF TRUTH** - 1 Timothy 4:3–5 - *“which God created to be received with thanksgiving by those who believe and know the truth.”*

**A. Receive God’s Gifts Thankfully** - *“to be received with thanksgiving.”*

**B. Recognize God’s Goodness** - *“For everything created by God is good...”*

**C. Rest in God’s Word** - *“for it is made holy by the word of God and prayer.”*

**Practical Applications**

- 1. Be Discerning** - Test everything by Scripture. Acts 17:11
- 2. Be Grounded** - Spend time in God’s Word consistently.
- 3. Be Thankful** - Thank God daily for His grace and provision.
- 4. Be Watchful** - Stay close to Christ.
