I. THE NEED FOR SPIRITUAL BIRTH -1-3

1. The APPROACH of Nicodemus - 3:1-2

"Nicodemus" – Nikodēmos – victory over the people

- Nicodemus was a Pharisee.
- Nicodemus was a scholar.
- Nicodemus was a politician.

A. His religious Persuasion – v. 1

Matthew 5:20, 16:6, 11-12, 23:23-33; Luke 16:14-15, 18:9-14

Remember...

"a ruler of the Jews" - Sanhedrin

² *This man came to Jesus by night...*

John 19:38–39, 7:47-52, 9:22

2. The ANSWER of Jesus - 3:3

- The REQUIREMENT of being "*born again*" in order to experience the Messianic Kingdom

"unless one is born again."

- The REALITY of the Messianic kingdom
"cannot see the kingdom."

"born-again" or "born from above"?

John 3:31 - ³¹ *He who comes from above is above all.*

The word above "*anōthen*" is same word as again in v. 3
