INTRODUCTION

REASSURANCE FOR THE FUTURE - 23-24 - His parting thoughts on the Lord

 Paul's <u>CONCERN</u> is rooted in our need of holiness "sanctify" – hagiazō - to set apart, separate, holy

Sanctification is the ongoing spiritual process by which God increasingly sets believers apart from sin and moves them toward holiness.

3 ASPECTS OF SANCTIFICATION:

- 1. <u>Positional</u> Sanctification which was accomplished through Christ's sacrifice at the moment of salvation. (1 Cor. 1:2, 30; 6:11; Heb. 10:10, 14; 13:12)
- 2. <u>Progressive</u> Sanctification which is ongoing throughout life. (2 Cor. 3:18; 7:1; Phil. 3:12-14; 1 Thess. 3:12-13; 4:3-8; 1 Pet. 1:15-16)
- 3. Perfect Sanctification which will happen the instant we see the Lord. (1 John 3:2)

"completely" - holos - "whole, complete" and teles - "end, finish"

"be kept blameless" - "be kept" – tēreō - "to watch over, guard, keep"
