"O righteous Father, even though the world does not know You, I know You, and these know that You have sent Me."

"I made known to them Your name, and I will continue to make it known, that the love with which You have loved Me may be in them..."

C. Participation in Divine Life - "...and I in them."

CONCLUSION

"That they may be with Me."

• His Desire for Our Perception

"That they may see My glory."

• His Desire for Our Participation

"That My love may be in them, and I in them."
