- Mighty in word & deeds- *Duet. 18:18-19*
- Arrested
- Sentenced to death - *Isaiah 53*
- Crucified
- Placed in a tomb
- Reports of a Resurrection - *Psalms 30:3*

III. - 25 - 27 - Jesus *TEACHES*

"He **OPENS** The scriptures"

"foolish ones" = *weakness or dull in Faith*

Moses - the Pentateuch

Prophets - Major & Minor

Psalms- 22:1-2

Interpreted - *explained, exposed, expounded*

The truth concerning Himself

IV. - 28 - 35 - Jesus *REVEALS*

"He **OPENS** Their Eyes"

- Invited to stay
- The breaking of bread
- Their eyes were opened
- He vanished from their sight
- Their hearts are changed
- They return to proclaim

V. - 36 - 48 - Jesus *GIVES UNDERSTANDING*

"He **OPENS** Their Minds"

John 14:26, 1 Cor. 2:10-16, 1 Cor. 15:12-1

- **Jesus appears**
- **Jesus calms their fears**
- **Jesus proves Himself**
- **Jesus speaks**
- **Jesus gives them understanding**
- **Jesus commissions them for The Gospel**
