INTRODUCTION

1. THE DEFIANT HEART IN FOOLS.

"The fool has said in his heart, "There is no God." Psalm14:1a

Practical Atheist: Someone who **BELIEVES** in God but **LIVES** as if He doesn't exist.

'The fear of the Lord is the beginning of wisdom.' Psalm 111:10a

2. THE DEPRAVED <u>LIFE</u> OF FOOLS.

"They are corrupt, they do abominable deeds, there is none who does good." Psalm 14:1b $\,$

Romans 1:18-21; Romans 1:24-25, 31

3. THE DISTURBING REVELATION ABOUT FOOLS.

"The Lord looks down from heaven upon the children of men, to see if there are any who understand, who seek God. They have all turned aside, they have together become corrupt; There is none who does good, No, not one." Psalm 14:2-3

O Every person is either a **CURRENT** or **FORMER** fool.

4. THE DIVINE HOPE FOR FOOLS.

"Have they no knowledge, all the evildoers who eat up my people as they eat bread and do not call upon the Lord? There they are in great terror, for God is with the generation of the righteous. You would shame the plans of the poor, but the Lord is his refuge. Oh, that salvation for Israel would come out of Zion! When the Lord restores the fortunes of his people, let Jacob rejoice, let Israel be glad." Psalm 14:4-7

O Only Jesus can <u>TRANSFORM</u> it.
