***True love for Christ is revealed through life in Him
and obedience to His Word.***

Love That Shows

- Love is more than words
- Love is revealed by obedience
- Love flows from relationship

I. A Living Union with Christ (John 14:19–20)

Because I Live...

- Christ is alive
- Our life is in Him
- The world cannot see—believers can

John 14:20 - “I am in my Father, and you in me, and I in you.”

Remember...

Your responsibility, by God's enabling, is to constantly apply the divine principles and truths you have heard (Phil. 2:12-13; 1 Tim. 4:7-9; Jam 1:22-27).

As you meditate on this message, ask yourself these questions:

How does God want my beliefs/actions to change?

How can I accomplish this change?

What is the first step toward bringing about this change?

II. A Loving Obedience to Christ (*John 14:21, 23–24*)

Love Is Shown By Obedience

- Obedience does not earn love
- Obedience proves love
- Disobedience reveals the heart

John 14:21 - *“Whoever has my commandments and keeps them, he it is who loves Me.”*

III. A Lasting Indwelling by God (*John 14:21, 23*)

God Makes His Home With Us

- Not a visit—but a dwelling
- Fellowship deepens through obedience
- Father and Son abide with believers

John 14:23 - *“We will come to him and make our home with him.”*

IV. A Revealed Truth from the Father (*John 14:24*)

God’s Word Has Authority

- Christ speaks the Father’s Word
- Rejecting the Word rejects God
- Obedience honors the Father

John 14:24 - *“The word that you hear is not mine but the Father’s who sent Me.”*
