THE AUTHOR – v. 1a

“Jude, a servant of Jesus Christ and brother of James”

- *Brother of James*

- *Servant of Jesus Christ*

THE AUDIENCE – v. 1b

“To those who are called, beloved in God the Father and kept for Jesus Christ”

To Those Who Are ...

- Called – “klētos”
“idea of being personally chosen or selected”

- Beloved - perfect passive participle “agapaō”
“The perfect tense indicates that God placed His love on believers in eternity past.”

- Kept - perfect passive participle “tetērēmenois”
“to observe, pay attention to, keep under guard, maintain”
