A. In The Description Of These People Who Crept In

- As to their Coming into the fellowship
"crept in unnoticed"
pareisduō - only here in the NT
slipping in secretly with an evil intention

- As to their Condemnation
"long ago were designated" v. 14 "progegrammenoi"
perfect tense of the participle - God pronounced damnation

- As to their Character
“ungodly”

- As to their Conduct
“who pervert the grace of our God into sensuality”

- As to their Creed
“deny our only Master and Lord, Jesus Christ”

B. In The Doctrine They Promote

- A Development of an attitude and practice of compromising with sin

- A Denial of the sovereignty and person of Jesus Christ
“Master” – despot
