#### 1. The ILLUSTRATION God used - 14

**NUMBERS 21** 

"as Moses lifted up the serpent in the wilderness" Numbers 21:5-9; John 12:31; Genesis 3:14-15; Galatians 3:13 "bronze" – symbol of judgement of God

Death - a punishment for sin		
God provided the remedy		
Something must be lifted up in public view Believing hearts who look to what is lifted up, are healed

#### Remember...

"that whoever believes in Him may have eternal life."

# III. THE MOTIVE OF GOD REQUIRES FAITH - 16

"For God so loved the world"

#### 1. The PROOF of God's love

"He gave His only Son"

1 John 3:16; 4:9-10; Rom. 5:8

# 2. The PREREQUISITE to experiencing God's love

"that whoever believes in Him"

# 3. The PROMISE of God's love

"should not perish but have eternal life."

## IV. THE MISSION OF GOD REQUIRES FAITH-17-21

<sup>17</sup> For God did not send his Son into the world to condemn the world, but in order that the world might be saved through him.

#### 1. His PURPOSE - v. 17

"not...to condemn...but ... saved"

#### 2. His PROMISE - v. 18

"he who believes in Him is not condemned" Romans 8:1

#### 3. Our <u>PROBLEM</u> – v. 18

"He who does not believe is condemned already"

# 4. Our PRACTICE - v. 19

"Practicing evil vs. "does the truth"

Sin keeps us from the Savior, but the Savior is the only One who can take away our sin.
