“Let Not Your Heart Be Troubled”

John 14:1-11

Jesus comforts troubled hearts by revealing Himself as the Way to the Father, the Truth that cannot change, and the Life that cannot die.

I. THE CURE FOR A TROUBLED HEART — FAITH IN CHRIST - v. 1

A **Person** to trust: *“Believe in Me.”*

Application: Faith is not denying reality — it’s trusting a greater reality. You may not know what the future holds, but you know who holds it.

Remember...

Your responsibility, by God’s enabling, is to constantly apply the divine principles and truths you have heard (Phil. 2:12-13; 1 Tim. 4:7-9; Jam 1:22-27).

As you meditate on this message, ask yourself these questions:

How does God want my beliefs/actions to change?

How can I accomplish this change?

What is the first step toward bringing about this change?

II. THE COMFORT OF A HEAVENLY HOME - vv. 2–3

A **Place** to look forward to: *“I go to prepare a place for you.”*

Application: Heaven is not merely a destination; it’s a relationship with Christ forever. We are not just going to a place — we’re going to a Person.

III. THE CLARITY OF THE ONLY WAY - vv. 4–6

A **Path** to follow: *“I am the way.”*

Application: In a world of confusion, Christ offers clarity. In a world of lies, He is the truth. In a world of death, He is life.

IV. The Revelation of the Father in the Son - vv. 7–11

A **Presence** to rely on: *“He who has seen Me has seen the Father.”*

Application: If you want to know what God is like — look at Jesus. You don’t need a vision, a dream, or a sign — you need Christ.

CONCLUSION

Jesus began this chapter with comfort and ended it with confidence. When the disciples’ hearts were troubled by uncertainty, He gave them:

- A Person to trust: *“Believe in Me.”*
- A Place to look forward to: *“I go to prepare a place for you.”*
- A Path to follow: *“I am the way.”*
- A Presence to rely on: *“He who has seen Me has seen the Father.”*

*So today, when your heart is troubled, remember —
Christ is not only the way to heaven; He is the way through life.*
