3 SIMPLE FACTS ABOUT YOUR RESURRECTION BODY

1. It's RELATIONSHIP To Your Present Body Makes You The Same Person. 36-38
2. It's RE-CREATION Makes You Different Person. 39-41
3. Its REALITIES Makes You Are Greater Person. 42-49

1. It's RELATIONSHIP To Your Present Body Makes You The Same Person. vv. 36-38

- The Requirement Of Death – 36 – *“What you sow does not come to life unless it dies.”*

- The Reaping Of What Is Sown – 37 – *“And what you sow is not the body that is to be, but a bare kernel, perhaps of wheat or of some other grain.”*

Remember...

Your responsibility, by God's enabling, is to constantly apply the divine principles and truths you have heard (Phil. 2:12-13; 1 Tim. 4:7-9; Jam 1:22-27). As you meditate on this message, ask yourself these questions:

How does God want my beliefs/actions to change?

How can I accomplish this change?

What is the first step toward bringing about this change?

- The Resource From Which Our New Bodies Will Come – 38 - “*But God gives it a body*”
- The Reason Behind It – 38 - “*as He has chosen*”
- The Relationship To Your Present Body – 38 - “*and to each kind of seed its own body*”

2. It's RE-CREATION Makes You Different Person. vv. 39-41

- The importance of a basic principle - “*For not all flesh is the same*”
- The illustrations:
 - Physical CREATURES – 39
 Four Different Categories:
 HUMANS - FISH - BEASTS - BIRDS
 One Common Denominator:
 “*another*” – Greek: *allos* – the same kind
All living, animate beings!
 - Material CREATION – 41
 Three Different Categories:
 SUN - MOON - STARS
 “*for star differs from star in glory.*”
 One Common Denominator:
 “*another*” – Greek: *allos* – the same kind
- The insight we gain – 40 – “*but the glory of the heavenly is of one kind, and the glory of the earthly is of another.*”
 “*another*” – Greek: *heteros* – another of a different kind
