

Why were we created?

So God created human beings in his own image. In the image of God he created them; male and female he created them. Then God blessed them and said, "Be fruitful and multiply. Fill the earth and govern it. Reign over the fish in the sea, the birds in the sky, and all the animals that scurry along the ground." Genesis 1:27–28, NLT

When I look at the night sky and see the work of your fingers— the moon and the stars you set in place— what are mere mortals that you should think about them, human beings that you should care for them? Yet you made them only a little lower than God and crowned them with glory and honor. You gave them charge of everything you made, putting all things under their authority...Psalm 8:3–6, NLT

Human beings are the pinnacle of God's creation.

The very essence of the nature of God is that God exists in community, in relationship.

What do theologians call the community of God?

"Father, I want those you have given me to be with me where I am, and to see my glory, the glory you have given me because you loved me before the creation of the world." John 17:24, NIV

Glimpses into the relationship in the Trinity.

And a voice from heaven said, "This is my dearly loved Son, who brings me great joy." Matthew 3:17, NLT

But even as he spoke, a bright cloud overshadowed them, and a voice from the cloud said, "This is my dearly loved Son, who brings me great joy. Listen to him." Matthew 17:5, NLT

And the one who sent me is with me—he has not deserted me. For I always do what pleases him. John 8:29, NLT

My prayer is not for them alone. I pray also for those who will believe in me through their message, that all of them may be one, Father, just as you are in me and I am in you. May they also be in us so that the world may believe that you have sent me. I have given them the glory that you gave me, that they may be one as we are one: I in them and you in me. May they be brought to complete unity to let the world know that you sent me and have loved them even as you have loved me. John 17:20–23, NIV

To build your marriage on the foundation God wants you to have, you must:

- 1. Receive your mate as God's sovereign and good gift to you personally, not as a fortuitous life circumstance.
- 2. Commit to a growing understanding of your mates relational/aloneness needs.
- 3. Acknowledge your mate as God's primary resource to meet your specific relational/aloneness needs and commit to revealing your heart to them.
- 4. Take personally responsibility from God to care for your mate's heart and their relational/aloneness needs.
