Icebreaker:

Describe an incident when you were disappointed by someone.

Sermon in a Sentence:

Only an "omni" God has the CAPACITY to satisfy our deepest needs for intimacy.

General Discussion [Groups of 4]:

Read Psalm 139

- 1. How does David feel about God's total knowledge of him (vv. 1-6)? Does he feel restricted or protected? Free or oppressed? How do you feel about God's total knowledge (omniscience) of you?
- 2. If God already knows your prayers (vs. 4), why bother to pray?
- 3. Why does David think about escaping God (vv. 7-12)? How do you feel about God's <u>omnipresence</u> with you? Is there a difficulty so dark, that God is not with you?
- 4. Through His <u>omnipotence</u> God created the universe and personally created you (vv. 13-16). Has science added or subtracted from your wonder of life? How do you feel about the notion that God personally crafted you in your mother's womb?
- 5. If our days are "ordained" (vs. 16), then do we have the freedom to choose our own actions?
- 6. How does vv. 17-18 reveal the "omni-care" of God?
- 7. What do you think of David's "hatred" (vv. 21-22)? Why are these verses here?
- 8. Why does David ask God to search his heart and thoughts (vv.23-24)? Why is intimacy with God at stake?

Application Discussion.

Describe how you practice vv. 23-24. Is this easy or hard for you? Why?
