Icebreaker:

Sermon in a Sentence:

2. What does Luke 12:7 mean to you?
3. In what ways are we like Gomer? How do you think the love of God (shown through Hosea) differs from our love?

Gospel-Centered Discussion:

4. What would be a fair price for your value? Why?
5. Why does knowing that God has determined your value and bought you at a high price - the life of His One and only Son who bore the penalty of your sins - encourage you to live in awe of Him?

Application Discussion:

6. What would you say is the central theme in the above passages, and how can you apply this theme in your life daily?
