- Ezra: He is seen as Lord of heaven and earth
- Nehemiah: as the builder
- Esther: as our Mordecai
- Job: our Daysman, and our Risen returning Redeemer
- Psalms: as the Son of God, and the Good Shepherd
- Proverbs: as our Wisdom
- Ecclesiastes: as the One above the sun
- Song of Solomon: the great Church lover, the One Altogether Lovely, and the Chiefest among ten thousand
- Isaiah: He is the suffering and glorified Servant
- Jeremiah: as the Lord our Righteousness
- Lamentations: as the Man of Sorrows
- Ezekiel: the glorious God
- Daniel: as the Smiting Stone, and the Messiah
- Hosea: reveals Him as the risen Son of God
- Joel: as the outpourer of the Spirit
- Amos: as the Eternal Christ
- Obadiah: as the Forgiving Christ
- Jonah: as the Risen Prophet
- Micah: as the Bethlehemite
- Nahum: He is the Bringer of Good Tidings

- Habakkuk: as the Lord in His Holy Temple
- Zephaniah: as the Merciful Christ
- Haggai: as the Desire of all nations
- Zechariah: as the Branch
- Malachi: as the Sun of Righteousness with healing in His wings

- Matthew: as King of the Jews
- Mark: as the Servant
- Luke: as the Perfect Son of Man
- John: as the Son of God
- Acts: He is the Ascended Lord
- Romans: as the Lord our Righteousness
- 1 Corinthians: as our Resurrection
- 2 Corinthians: as our Comforter
- Galatians: as the end of the Law
- Ephesians: as the head of the Church
- Philippians: as the Supplier of every need
- Colossians: as the Fullness of the Godhead
- 1 Thessalonians: He comes for His Church
- 2 Thessalonians: He comes with His Church
- 1 Timothy: He is the Mediator
- 2 Timothy: as the Bestower of Crowns
- Titus: as our Great God and Savior
- Philemon: as the Payer of our Debt
- Hebrews: the rest of the Faith, and the Fulfiller of Types
- James: as the Lord drawing nigh
- 1 Peter: as the Vicarious Sufferer
- 2 Peter: as the Lord of Glory
- 1 John: as the Way
- 2 John: as the Truth
- 3 John: as the Life
- Jude: He is our Security
- Revelation: as the Lion of the Tribe of Judah, the Lamb of God, the Bright and Morning Star, the King of kings, and Lord of lords
