- •Lions are the only known cat species that roars together with even young cubs joining in. can be heard from 5 miles away.
- Lions roar almost exclusively at night. A recent study found that there is a peak of vocalizing near dawn...
 - More likely to roar repeatedly near rivers and water points.
- •THEY HUNT DURING STORMS-The noise, rain and/or wind make it harder for prey to see and hear them, increasing their chances of a successful hunt.
- •People with a **ROAR** attitude are **BOLD**. They are courageous to stand for what they believe. They are brave to go a different direction when everyone else is going another way. They are willing to face their adversaries and challenges even if they are scared.

- •People with the **ROAR** attitude achieve because they are **bold** enough to fight. They accept that their future is dependent on the choices they make today.
- •Elephant Story- He saw a trainer nearby and asked why these animals just stood there and made no attempt to get away. "Well," trainer said, "when they are very young and much smaller we use the same size rope to tie them and, at that age, it's enough to hold them. As they grow up, they are conditioned to believe they cannot break away. They believe the rope can still hold them, so they never try to break free."
