GALATIANS 1:6-9

I am amazed that you are <u>so quickly deserting Him</u> who called you by the grace of Christ, <u>for a different gospel</u>; ⁷ which is <u>really</u> not another; only there are some who are <u>disturbing you</u> and <u>want to distort the gospel of Christ</u>. ⁸ But even if we, or an angel from heaven, should preach to you a gospel contrary to what we have preached to you, he is to be accursed! ⁹ As we have said before, so I say again now, if any man is preaching to you a gospel contrary to what you received, he is to be accursed!

GALATIANS 2:19-21

For through the Law I died to the Law, so that I might live to God. ²⁰ "I have been crucified with Christ; and it is no longer I who live, but Christ lives in me; and the life which I now live in the flesh I live by faith in the Son of God, who loved me and gave Himself up for me. ²¹ "I do not nullify the grace of God, for if righteousness comes through the Law, then Christ died needlessly."

But the Scripture has shut up everyone under sin, so that the promise by faith in Jesus Christ might be given to those who believe. ²³ But before faith came, we were kept in custody under the law, being shut up to the faith which was later to be revealed. ²⁴ Therefore the Law has become our tutor to lead us to Christ, so that we may be justified by faith. ²⁵ But now that faith has come, we are no longer under a tutor. ²⁶ For you are all sons of God through faith in Christ Jesus.







Galatians 4:1-7

Now I say, as long as the heir is a child, he does not differ at all from a slave although he is owner of everything, ² but he is under guardians and managers until the date set by the father. 3 So also we, while we were children, were held in bondage under the elemental things of the world. 4 But when the fullness of the time came, God sent forth His Son, born of a woman, born under the Law, ⁵ so that He might redeem those who were under the Law, that we might receive the adoption as sons. ⁶ Because you are sons, God has sent forth the Spirit of His Son into our hearts, crying, "Abba! Father!" ⁷ Therefore you are no longer a slave, but a son; and if a son, then an heir through God.

However, at that time, when you did not know God, you were slaves to those which by nature are no gods. 9 But now that you have come to know God, or rather to be known by God, how is it that you turn back again to the weak and worthless elemental things, to which you desire to be enslaved all over again?

⁷ Therefore you are no longer a slave,

but a son;

and if a son, then an heir through God.

Romans 8:15-17 (NASB95)

For you have not received a spirit of slavery leading to fear again, but you have received a spirit of adoption as sons by which we cry out, "Abba! Father!" 16 The Spirit Himself testifies with our spirit that we are children of God, 17 and if children, heirs also, heirs of God and fellow heirs with Christ, if indeed we suffer with Him so that we may also be glorified with Him.



Discussion Questions

- 1. Doubt: What are some attacks* we experience, where our assurance about our relationship with our Heavenly Father is tested? What are the damages (or additional spiritual problems) that rise from living in doubt / lack of assurance for a prolonged time?
- 2. Identity as Sons: I hope you feel the power of your identity as a child of God in Christ.
 - a. What are the implications of our spiritual Identity as a child of God?
 - b. Were there moments for you, where your Identity as a child of God mattered & impacted you? ... perhaps helped you through spiritual difficulties?
- 3. Meditate from God's perspective: What does God think / How does God feel when He sees His children reverting to legalism, trusting works of flesh & acting like employees?
- 4. Thankfulness: Any reflections of gratitude for what God has done in the "fullness of time?"
