Inductive Bible Study

- What to look for in making observations
 - Identify the key words that help identify thought flow of the text. (and, but, for, therefore, if, as in order that, that, any lists, repeated words, contrasts, cause and effect etc.)
 - Identify action words.
 - What are the main points and what are the subpoints?
 - When possible organize the thought flow as if you were going to teach this in some format.

- Discussion Questions
 - Who is the person that had the most impact on your life past or present that you model your spiritual life after?
 - How would a non-Christian who observes your life characterize your life? Do you think they would see evidence of saving faith in your life?
 - When you became a Christian what did you put away in order to follow Christ? Is there anything that you are struggling to put away today in order to be a better follower of Christ?
 - How often do you consider the second coming of Christ? Does his second coming have a practical impact on the way you live your life today? If yes, how? If no, why not?
