Psalms 33:1 Shout for joy in the LORD, O you righteous! raise befits the upright. Give thanks to the LORD with e lyre; make melody to him ith the harp of ten strings! Sing to him a new song; play killfully on the strings, with ud shouts. 4 For the word of e LORD is upright, and all his ork is done in faithfulness. He loves righteousness and stice; the earth is full of the eadfast love of the LORD. By the word of the LORD the eavens were made, and by e breath of his mouth all their ost. 7 He gathers the waters of e sea as a heap; he puts the eeps in storehouses. 8 Let all e earth fear the LORD; let all e inhabitants of the world and in awe of him! 9 For he ooke, and it came to be; he ommanded, and it stood firm. The LORD brings the counsel the nations to nothing; he ustrates the plans of the eoples. 11 The counsel of the ORD stands forever, the plans his heart to all generations. 2 Blessed is the nation whose od is the LORD, the people hom he has chosen as his eritage! 13 The LORD looks own from heaven; he sees all e children of man; 14 from here he sits enthroned he oks out on all the inhabitants the earth, 15 he who shions the hearts of them all nd observes all their deeds. 6 The king is not saved by his reat army: a warrior is not elivered by his great strength. 7 The war horse is a false ope for salvation, and by its reat might it cannot rescue. Behold, the eye of the LORD on those who fear him, on ose who hope in his steadfast ve, 19 that he may deliver their soul from death and keep them alive in famine. 20 Our soul waits for the LORD: he is our help and our shield. 21 For our heart is glad in him, because we trust in his holy name. 22 Let your steadfast love, O Lord, be upon us, even as we hope in you. ## **Application Questions**

- 2. Read **Deuteronomy 4:5-8**. How can we as God's people in our generation (like the nation of Israel in theirs) boost this enthusiastic sense of undeserved privilege, and live like it is true?
- 3. Read **Proverbs 3:5-6**. What are some of the ways we Christians are accustomed to the "half-hearted" trusting of God and the reliance on our own understanding? What are the symptoms that this is happening?
- 4. Read **Psalm 144:1-3**. Why is the humble perspective of v.3 helpful when considering God's provisions in your life including your skills, talents, gifts, opportunities, and successes? What is the risk when you fail to see it this way?
