# Application Questions

3. Read **Psalm 78:40-55** and **90:11**. Both of these passages refer to the period of the Exodus. How can expressions of God's destructive judgment be cause for worship and praise?
4. Read **Psalm 29:10-11**. How would you explain to a new Christian the importance of keeping God's authority and power in view when we ask him for things?
