Psalm 8

*TO THE CHOIRMASTER:
ACCORDING TO THE GITTITH.
A PSALM OF DAVID.*

1. Look _____ (vv.1b-4)

***1** O LORD, our Lord, how majestic is your name in all the earth! You have set your glory above the heavens. **2** Out of the mouth of babies and infants, you have established strength because of your foes, to still the enemy and the avenger. **3** When I look at your heavens, the work of your fingers, the moon and the stars, which you have set in place, **4** what is man that you are mindful of him, and the son of man that you care for him?*

2. Acknowledge _____ (vv.5-8)

***5** Yet you have made him a little lower than the heavenly beings and crowned him with glory and honor. **6** You have given him dominion over the works of your hands; you have put all things under his feet, **7** all sheep and oxen, and also the beasts of the field, **8** the birds of the heavens, and the fish of the sea, whatever passes along the paths of the seas.*

3. Purpose _____ (vv.1a, 9)

***9** O LORD, our Lord, how majestic is your name in all the earth! (ESV)*

3. Read **Genesis 1:26-31**. Describe the God-given honor associated with being a human in light of the subsequent entrance of sin into the world. What has changed and what has not?

4. Read **Matthew 10:29-31**. Why does thoughtful, accurate, and regular worship (ascribing to God the credit he deserves) impact our level of peace or anxiety?
