Application Questions

- 2. Read **Luke 17:15-18**. Why is ingratitude toward God such a problem, especially knowing that all of this concern to joyfully give thanks is not because God "needs" the attention or adulation from creatures like us?
- 3. Read **Colossians 1:12-14**. How can and should these truths fuel our worship and thanksgiving to God? Why is it important to not simply give thanks for our temporal blessings?
- 4. Read **Romans 12:1-2**. What would you say to someone who tells you he feels thankful to God but never serves the ministry of Christ or gives financially to the cause of Christ?
