I. Introduction

Ezra 9:8-9 "But now, for a brief moment, the Lord our God has been gracious in leaving us a remnant and giving us a firm place in his sanctuary, and so our God gives light to our eyes and a little relief in our bondage. Though we are slaves, our God has not forsaken us in our bondage. He has shown us kindness in the sight of the kings of Persia: He has granted us new life to rebuild the house of our God and repair its ruins, and he has given us a wall of protection in Judah and Jerusalem.

II. The Past Shapes Your Moment

- The past is a reminder of what you did.
- The past is a reminder of what God has done.

Nehemiah 9:31 But in your great mercy you did not put an end to them or abandon them, for you are a gracious and merciful God.

A. How do I respond to my past?

- 1. Respond with Humility

B. Don't live in your past. Launch from your past.

• What God saves is more important than what has been lost.

III. The Future Focuses Your Moment

A. How do I approach my future?

1. Approach the future with Vision.

Proverbs 29:18 (KJV) Where there is no vision, the people perish: but he that keepeth the law, happy is he.

Proverbs 29:18 Where there is no revelation, people cast off restraint; but blessed is the one who heeds wisdom's instruction.

2. Approach the future with Wisdom.

Luke 12:28-30 "Suppose one of you wants to build a tower. Won't you first sit down and estimate the cost to see if you have enough money to complete it? For if you lay the foundation and are not able to finish it, everyone who sees it will ridicule you, saying, 'This person began to build and wasn't able to finish.'

3. Approach the future with the Leading of the Holy Spirit.

Zechariah 4:6 So he said to me, "This is the word of the Lord to Zerubbabel: 'Not by might nor by power, but by my Spirit,' says the Lord Almighty.

B. Calvary's vision is LIFE CHANGE.

- 1. LIFE CHANGE happens when we CONNECT, GROW, and SERVE.
- 2. We want the church to grow both deep and wide.

3. You will be hindered by obstacles until you understand the power of moments.

Lamentations 3:22-23 Because of the Lord's great love we are not consumed, for his compassions never fail. They are new every morning; great is your faithfulness.

- 3. Your focus is not just on this moment but on the God of this moment.
- 4. "It is not about what you create. It is about what is created in you."
