1) What was the last thing you went on a rant about? Why did it bother you?

Read Matthew 11:21 – "Woe to you, Chorazin! Woe to you, Bethsaida! For if the miracles that were performed in you had been performed in Tyre and Sidon, they would have repented long ago in sackcloth and ashes."

- 2) What comes to mind when you hear the term, "repentance?"
- 3) What is one thing you have changed in your life because of repentance?

Read Proverbs 28:13-14 – "Whoever conceals their sins does not prosper, but the one who confesses and renounces them finds mercy. 14 Blessed is the one who always trembles before God, but whoever hardens their heart falls into trouble."

- 4) What is true repentance? What does Scripture tell us about repentance?
- 5) Have you ever hung onto a sin because you felt justified in feeling that way? (ie: anger or a grudge about someone)
- 6) How has repentance changed you or someone around you?

Read Matthew 11:20 – "Then Jesus began to denounce the towns in which most of his miracles had been performed, because they did not repent."

- 7) Is it hard to admit when you are wrong? Why?
- 8) What do you think prevents people from repenting?

Read 2 Corinthians 5:10 – "For we must all appear before the judgment seat of Christ, so that each of us may receive what is due us for the things done while in the body, whether good or bad."

- 9) What would you change in your life if you could?
- 10) Why is apathy about God and faith considered worse than having no faith?
