1. Favor

Jude 1:22-23 Be merciful to those who doubt; save others by snatching them from the fire; to others show mercy, mixed with fear—hating even the clothing stained by corrupted flesh.

2. Anointing

- A. There is divine anointing in unity.
- B. God's purpose for His Church is bigger than any cultural moment.

Mark 3:18 Andrew, Philip, Bartholomew, Matthew, Thomas, James son of Alphaeus, Thaddaeus, Simon the Zealot

- Let a humble spirit come before holy zeal.
- Let unity change the situation.
