1) What was your first understanding of how salvation works? Has it changed since?

Read Acts 15:11 – “No! We believe it is through the grace of our Lord Jesus that we are saved, just as they are.”

2) Why do you think people assume salvation requires Jesus, plus something?

Read Acts 15:29-31 – “You are to abstain from food sacrificed to idols, from blood, from the meat of strangled animals and from sexual immorality. You will do well to avoid these things. Farewell. So the men were sent off and went down to Antioch, where they gathered the church together and delivered the letter. 31 The people read it and were glad for its encouraging message.”

3) In light of the acronym, “GPS” (God, People, Self), how should we apply it in decision making?

4) How should GPS affect decisions concerning morality?

Read 1 Corinthians 15:32-33 – “Do not cause anyone to stumble, whether Jews, Greeks or the church of God— 33 even as I try to please everyone in every way. For I am not seeking my own good but the good of many, so that they may be saved.”

5) Why is it important to think of others when making personal decisions of conscience?

6) What are some simple, practical steps we can take to apply the GPS principle to our daily lives?
