## Children Need Us

- I. Introduction (skit guys video/ KZ band)
  - A. Review series: Something More. My purpose is to provoke us to a deeper and more productive spiritual life in 2023.
  - B. Today we'll focus on our responsibility for children both in our family our community and the world. [Psalm 127:3 (NLT) **Children are a gift from the Lord**; they are a reward from him.] Sadly, not everyone thinks so. We'll talk about how God values children and our responsibility to care for them and shape their thinking and values. In 1973 the Supreme Court legalized abortion on demand. Every year since, we remembered this tragic decision on this weekend. Estimates vary but approx. 63 million children were never given the chance to live. However, in 2022 the Supreme Court reversed Roe Vs Wade and left abortion decisions to the states. PTL! So, what now? AR. and TX. are both right to life states but what happens to the children after they're born? Who cares for them if the parent can't or won't? Who is responsible for what they're being taught and exposed to in school, media, and culture?

- II. When does life begin? (Why I'm pro-life)
  - A. [Luke 1:41 (ESV) And when Elizabeth heard the greeting of Mary, **the baby leaped in her womb...**][Psalm 139:13–16 (NLT) **You (God) made all the delicate, inner parts of my body and knit me together in my mother's womb.**]

B. When Roe vs. Wade passed science didn't know when a human life/personhood began. Today there's no question that human life begins at conception. However, some still demand a right to murder a child in the name of choice and convenience. It is every Christian's responsibility to continue to stand for the most vulnerable among us from conception to natural death. One way is voting. The wrong people in political office could pass laws making abortion unrestricted again. We must be vigilant in our stand for life! Elections matter. Pres. Trump appointed 3 pro-life Supreme Court judges. Senators.

### III. What does the Lord think about children?

A. [Mt. 19:13–15 (NLT)...some parents brought their children to Jesus so he could... pray for them. But the disciples scolded the parents for **bothering him**. 14 But **Jesus said, “Let the children come to me. Don't stop them...15 And he placed his hands on their heads and blessed them** before he left.]

B. Jesus loves kids. He's concerned about their care and future. We should be, too. Today's culture isn't. WND<sup>2</sup> If Americans throughout their nation's history have embraced any common values, at the top of the list would be the conviction that children are precious, innocent, a gift from God – and to be protected at all costs. Why then, in today's America, are so many adults destroying children– from aborting them right up to the moment of birth, to killing them after they're born, to sexualizing them virtually from birth (Harvard now teaches a course on infants who are “LGBTQIA+),” to transporting 2- and 3-year-olds to events glorifying drag queens. As they grow older, America's children are systematically sexualized in public school classrooms (Texarkana?) and after-school LGBT “support clubs,” as well as by transgender recruiters on social media platforms. Many children are seduced into “identifying” as the opposite gender, or a brand-new imaginary gender, and are convinced – and permitted – to take powerful drugs and hormones, and to have their healthy breasts amputated or to undergo castration. They are indoctrinated with Marxist ideologies like “critical race theory,” intended to condition them to hate and reject their own country, their parents, their faith, their race, their gender and themselves. As a result youth suicides and other mental and emotional disorders have skyrocketed. Even violent crime at an early age is becoming an increasing reality. Meanwhile, the opioid fentanyl is the # 1 cause of death of young people. Just prior to Halloween – it was disguised as candy.

Make no mistake, the harm being done to children in this war is neither accidental nor collateral: Children are the primary target. The left's worst nightmare is a nation of kids raised learning about God and Jesus, the Ten Commandments, the Sermon on the Mount, the Golden Rule, sexual morality, and righteousness.

- c. Warning from Jesus [Mark 9:42 (NCV)] "If one of these little children believes in me, and **someone causes that child to sin**, it would be better for that person to have a large stone tied around his neck and be drowned in the sea.]Refers to severe judgment

#### IV. What responsibility does the Bible give Christians for caring for children outside our family and shaping their values?

- A. [James 1:27 (NLT)] **Pure and genuine religion** in the sight of God the Father means caring for **orphans**...in their distress...] Def. orphan: A child who is deprived of father or mother or of both<sup>1</sup> due to death or abandonment.

#### v. What is COTR doing to care for children and instill Biblical values.(panel stage)

- A. KZ ministers to an average of 476 children on weekends and Wed. night. The average # of workers is 72-94 per week; we could use 110. Great opportunity to influence.

- B. This fall, PH youth church ranged from 90-210 teenagers on Wed night, have student led ministries on 6 area school campuses. Pic Students praying sports teams.

- C. In TXK we opened Grace House for homeless single moms and their kids; every week SSS goes to 4-5 apartment complexes to care for kids and teach the Bible and citizenship, we provide assistance to local school teachers, and diaper drives. We feed and clothe children in Haiti, Kenya and many other nations. Our upcoming mission trips to Thailand/ Mexico will provide 250 pairs of shoes.

World Net Daily: If Americans throughout their nation's history have embraced any common values, at the top of the list would be the conviction that children are precious, innocent, a gift from God – and to be protected at all costs. Why then, in today's America, are so many adults destroying children in a dizzying variety of ways – from aborting them right up to the moment of birth, to killing them after they're born, to sexualizing them virtually from birth (Harvard now teaches a course on infants who are "LGBTQIA+," "queer" or "asexual"), to injecting them with an experimental "vaccine" proven to be both ineffective and dangerous, to transporting 2- and 3-year-olds to events glorifying mentally ill, demonically possessed men dressed as women (some with criminal histories of child sexual abuse) who regale America's next generation with fantastical stories about heroic LGBT characters? And this is just the abuse heaped daily on infants and toddlers. As they grow older, America's children are systematically sexualized in government ("public") school classrooms and after-school LGBT "support clubs," as well as by ubiquitous transgender recruiters on social media platforms like TikTok. C. 1 Samuel 1:1–2:11 (NLT) There was a man named Elkanah who lived in Ramah in the region of Zuph in the hill country of Ephraim. He was the son of Jeroham, son of Elihu, son of Tohu, son of Zuph, of Ephraim. 2 Elkanah had two wives, Hannah and Peninnah. Peninnah had children, but Hannah did not. 3 Each year Elkanah would travel to Shiloh to worship and sacrifice to the Lord of Heaven’s Armies at the Tabernacle. The priests of the Lord at that time were the two sons of Eli—Hophni and Phinehas. 4 On the days Elkanah presented his sacrifice, he would give portions of the meat to Peninnah and each of her children. 5 And though he loved Hannah, he would give her only one choice portion because the Lord had given her no children. 6 So Peninnah would taunt Hannah and make fun of her because the Lord had kept her from having children. 7 Year after year it was the same—Peninnah would taunt Hannah as they went to the Tabernacle. Each time, Hannah would be reduced to tears and would not even eat. 8 “Why are you crying, Hannah?” Elkanah would ask. “Why aren’t you eating? Why be downhearted just because you have no children? You have me— isn’t that better than having ten sons?” 9 Once after a sacrificial meal at Shiloh, Hannah got up and went to pray. Eli the priest was sitting at his customary place beside the entrance of the Tabernacle. 10 Hannah was in deep anguish, crying bitterly as she prayed to the Lord. 11 And she made this vow: “O Lord of Heaven’s Armies, if you will look upon my sorrow and answer my prayer and give me a son, then I will give him back to you. He will be yours for his entire lifetime, and as a sign that he has been dedicated to the Lord, his hair will never be cut.” 12 As she was praying to the Lord, Eli watched her. 13 Seeing her lips moving but hearing no sound, he thought she had been drinking. 14 “Must you come here drunk?” he demanded. “Throw away your wine!” 15 “Oh no, sir!” she replied. “I haven’t been drinking wine or anything stronger. But I am very discouraged, and I was pouring out my heart to the Lord. 16 Don’t think I am a wicked woman! For I have been praying out of great anguish and sorrow.” 17 “In that case,” Eli said, “go in peace! May the God of Israel grant the request you have asked of him.” 18 “Oh, thank you, sir!” she exclaimed. Then she went back and began to eat again, and she was no longer sad. 19 The entire family got up early the next morning and went to worship the Lord once more. Then they returned home to Ramah. When

Elkanah slept with Hannah, the Lord remembered her plea, 20 and in due time she gave birth to a son. She named him Samuel, for she said, "I asked the Lord for him." 21 The next year Elkanah and his family went on their annual trip to offer a sacrifice to the Lord and to keep his vow. 22 But Hannah did not go. She told her husband, "Wait until the boy is weaned. Then I will take him to the Tabernacle and leave him there with the Lord permanently." 23 "Whatever you think is best," Elkanah agreed. "Stay here for now, and may the Lord help you keep your promise." So she stayed home and nursed the boy until he was weaned. 24 When the child was weaned, Hannah took him to the Tabernacle in Shiloh. They brought along a three-year-old bull for the sacrifice and a basket of flour and some wine. 25 After sacrificing the bull, they brought the boy to Eli. 26 "Sir, do you remember me?" Hannah asked. "I am the very woman who stood here several years ago praying to the Lord. 27 I asked the Lord to give me this boy, and he has granted my request. 28 Now I am giving him to the Lord, and he will belong to the Lord his whole life." And they worshiped the Lord there. 1 Then Hannah prayed: "My heart rejoices in the Lord! The Lord has made me strong. Now I have an answer for my enemies; I rejoice because you rescued me. 2 No one is holy like the Lord! There is no one besides you; there is no Rock like our God. 3 "Stop acting so proud and haughty! Don't speak with such arrogance! For the Lord is a God who knows what you have done; he will judge your actions. 4 The bow of the mighty is now broken, and those who stumbled are now strong. 5 Those who were well fed are now starving, and those who were starving are now full. The childless woman now has seven children, and the woman with many children wastes away. 6 The Lord gives both death and life; he brings some down to the grave but raises others up. 7 The Lord makes some poor and others rich; he brings some down and lifts others up. 8 He lifts the poor from the dust and the needy from the garbage dump. He sets them among princes, placing them in seats of honor. For all the earth is the Lord's, and he has set the world in order. 9 "He will protect his faithful ones, but the wicked will disappear in darkness. No one will succeed by strength alone. 10 Those who fight against the Lord will be shattered. He thunders against them from heaven; the Lord judges throughout the earth. He gives power to his king; he increases the strength of his anointed one." 11 Then Elkanah returned home to Ramah without Samuel. And the boy served the Lord by assisting Eli the priest.
