I Have Saved the Best Till Now!

John 2:10 *"Everyone brings out the choice wine first and then the cheaper wine after the guests have had too much to drink; but YOU HAVE SAVED THE BEST TILL NOW."*

Prophecy: ***I Have Saved the Best Till Now!***

Over marriages. Over ministries. Over this church. Over Businesses.

Hag. 2:9 *'The glory of this present house will be greater than the glory of the former house,' says the Lord Almighty. 'And IN THIS PLACE I WILL GRANT PEACE,' declares the Lord Almighty.'* (NIV)

'This Temple IS GOING TO END UP FAR BETTER THAN IT STARTED OUT, a glorious beginning but an even more glorious finish: a place in which I will hand out wholeness and holiness.' TM

GREATER = more glorious, more splendid, far better than it started out.

PEACE/SHALOM = wholeness, holiness, soundness, health, prosperity

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Complete, lacking nothing. Body (health), soul (emotional well being) and spirit (right relationship with God).

John 2:1-11 NIV Jesus Changes Water to Wine

On the third day a wedding took place at Cana in Galilee. Jesus' mother was there, ² and Jesus and his disciples had also been invited to the wedding. ³ When the wine was gone, Jesus' mother said to him, "They have no more wine."

⁴ *"Dear woman, why do you involve me?" Jesus replied. "My time has not yet come."*

⁵ *His mother said to the servants, "Do whatever he tells you."*

⁶ *Nearby stood six stone water jars, the kind used by the Jews for ceremonial washing, each holding from twenty to thirty gallons.*

⁷ *Jesus said to the servants, "Fill the jars with water"; so they filled them to the brim.*

⁸ *Then he told them, "Now draw some out and take it to the master of the banquet."*

They did so,⁹ and the master of the banquet tasted the water that had been turned into wine. He did not realize where it had come from, though the servants who had drawn the water knew. Then he called the bridegroom aside¹⁰ and said, "Everyone brings out the choice wine first and then the cheaper wine after the guests have had too much to drink; but you have saved the best till now."

¹¹ This, the first of his miraculous signs, Jesus performed at Cana in Galilee. He thus revealed his glory, and his disciples put their faith in him.

1. JUST DO IT!

John 2:5 *His mother said to the servants, "DO WHATEVER HE TELLS YOU."*

Key to seeing this promise fulfilled: JUST DO IT!

God has instructed you in His Word and by His Spirit what you need to do to turn your situation around. Prophetic words have been spoken. Counsel has been given. The Word of the Lord to you is: **JUST DO IT!** Do whatever He says. Obey His Word.

2. DO IT WHOLEHEARTEDLY

John 2:7 *Jesus said to the servants, "Fill the jars with water." SO THEY FILLED THEM TO THE BRIM.*

Don't obey the word half heartedly. Don't obey the word mostly. If you're going to do it, DO IT WITH ALL YOUR HEART. Do it with CONVICTION.

Do it with EXPECTATION.

2 Kings 13:14-19 NIV **Jehoash & Elisha**

Now Elisha was suffering from the illness from which he died. Jehoash king of Israel went down to see him and wept over him. "My father! My father!" he cried. "The chariots and horsemen of Israel!"

15 Elisha said, "Get a bow and some arrows," and he did so. 16 "Take the bow in your hands," he said to the king of Israel. When he had taken it, Elisha put his hands on the king's hands.

17 "Open the east window," he said, and he opened it. "Shoot!" Elisha said, and he shot. "The Lord's arrow of victory, the arrow of victory over Aram!" Elisha declared. "You will completely destroy the Arameans at Aphek."

18 Then he said, "Take the arrows," and the king took them. Elisha told him, "Strike the ground." He struck it three times and stopped. 19 The man of God was angry with him and said, "You should have struck the ground five or six times; then you would have defeated Aram and completely destroyed it. But now you will defeat it only three times."

King Jehoshaphat did everything that Elisha told him to do, but he didn't do it wholeheartedly. He only destroyed the enemy 3 times because of his half-hearted obedience.

Wholehearted = with zeal, passion, fire, put your heart into it, go the extra mile, don't give up or quit, don't allow yourself to become weary, stay focused

3. STEP OUT IN FAITH

John 2:8 Then He told them, "Now draw some out and take it to the master of the banquet." They did so... Jesus said and they did... TM

The servants obeyed Jesus and then risked everything by taking a step of faith and bringing the jar of water to the master of the banquet. What if it was just water? What if it was inferior and not complete? Took a step of faith.

John 4:46-54 NIV Jesus Heals the Official's Son

46 Once more he visited Cana in Galilee, where he had turned the water into wine. And there was a certain royal official whose son lay sick at Capernaum. 47 When this man heard that Jesus had arrived in Galilee from Judea, he went to him and begged him to come and heal his son, who was close to death.

48 "Unless you people see miraculous signs and wonders," Jesus told him, "you will never believe."

49 The royal official said, "Sir, come down before my child dies."

50 Jesus replied, "You may go. Your son will live." THE MAN TOOK JESUS AT HIS WORD AND DEPARTED. 51 While he was still on the way, his servants met him with the news that his boy was living. 52 When he

inquired as to the time when his son got better, they said to him, "The fever left him yesterday at the seventh hour."

53 Then the father realized that this was the exact time at which Jesus had said to him, "Your son will live." So he and all his household believed.

54 This was the second miraculous sign that Jesus performed, having come from Judea to Galilee.

This man had no proof that the miracle had taken place. It wasn't confirmed by eye witnesses. It wasn't confirmed by doctors. He didn't personally witness the healing. HE TOOK JESUS AT HIS WORD. By faith He believed that what Jesus promised, He was going to do it.

Often the miracle doesn't happen until you step out as if it was already done.

You have to STEP OUT IN FAITH, believing the promise of God. Peter had to step out of the boat, never having walked on water, and trust Jesus to sustain him. Peter had to let down his net, even though he had fished all night and knew the fish weren't biting, but BY FAITH he trusted Jesus' word.

Conclusion:

The Prophetic Word has come: *I Have Saved the Best Till Now*

You can either take Him at His Word or you can say, "I've already tried that. It's no use. It's hopeless."

God will not give you new direction until you fully obey what he has already told you to do.

Quit making excuses. Quit trying to figure it out with your own mind. Jesus said do it, so therefore I am going to do it with my whole heart and not stop until the victory comes. I am going to step out in faith believing His promise.

Heb. 10:23 *Let us hold firmly to the hope that we have confessed, because WE CAN TRUST GOD TO DO WHAT HE PROMISED.* (NCV)

Num. 23:19 *God is not like men, who lie; He is not a human who changes his mind. WHATEVER HE PROMISES HE DOES; HE SPEAKS, AND IT IS DONE.* (TEV)
