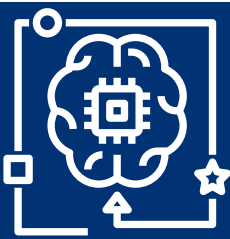

## STUDY THE WORD

- Compare Pilate’s response to Jesus (vv. 1–5) with the centurion’s response to Jesus (vv. 37–39). How are these similar or different? Are they significant? Why?
- I mentioned that Mark only uses three Greek words to describe the actual crucifixion of Jesus. What does he spend more time writing about? Why do you think that is?
- Look through vv. 1–32, where Mark uses a lot of repetition for a couple of phrases. See if you can identify those and why you think he uses them. What is the connection?
- Jesus is utterly alone in this passage. Who are the “pseudo-disciples” or “anti-disciples” in this passage? Why are they significant?

## MEMORIZE THE WORD



*If anyone would come after me, let him deny himself and take up his cross and follow me.*

## APPLY THE WORD

- Following Jesus necessarily means “taking up your cross.” What might that look like in your daily life?
- How has the study in *Living by the Book* helped you in your study of God’s Word?
- What is one takeaway you’ve gotten from our time together in the Gospel of Mark and in our time together in this bible study? What is one transforming truth (application) that you plan on making as a result in your life?
