

WORSHIP THROUGH THE BODY

- **Sermon Question: What should we expect from the world as we follow Christ?**
- **Do you personally experience opposition in the Christian life? If so, how? If not, why? When you engage in following him more closely (e.g., resolve to study his Word, to teach others, to disciple others), how does the opposition change?**
- **Of the four main questions in the sermon Sunday [i.e., Can Jesus really forgive sin? How low will Jesus go? How should Jesus' disciples act (Fasting)? How should Jesus' disciples worship (Sabbath)?], which one resonated the most with you? Why?**
- **How has your thinking on Exodus 20:9-11 changed in light of Jesus' answer to the Pharisees about the Sabbath?**
- **In your experience in the Christian life, where have you experienced more opposition—from others or from within? Why?**



WORSHIP THROUGH SCRIPTURE MEMORY

WORSHIP THROUGH PRACTICE

- **Forgiveness.** Jesus claims authority to forgive sins. Do you really believe that? How can you be more forgiving of yourself in light of this and/or how can you extend forgiveness more easily to another in your life this week?
- **Going “low.”** Jesus dined with sinners. Are you willing to go out of your way this week to invite a stranger into fellowship with us—someone whom you don’t know or associate with, someone that you wouldn’t normally speak with? If so, how will you hold yourself accountable to another to make that happen?
- **Tradition.** The people and Pharisees questioned the disciples’ actions and worship. What “small” things do you hold onto tightly in the church? How can you let those things go for the good of the gospel going out at SBCC.
