GROW: Going Deeper for Personal Study and Application

- **Reflect:** Where in my life have I separated faith from everyday responsibility? Is my work aligned with surrender? Is my home aligned with mission? Is my heart aligned with Christ? Take a few minutes this week to ask the Lord to show you one area that needs realignment.
- **Read & Pray:** Read [Acts 18:1–4](#) again slowly. Pray this: “Lord, align my life with Your mission. Use my work, my relationships, and my obedience for Your glory. Keep my heart surrendered. Make me ready wherever You place me.” If married, pray together for spiritual alignment. If single, pray for wisdom and direction in future relationships.
- **Take a Step:** Identify one person at your workplace you will intentionally pray for this week. Have one intentional spiritual conversation, even if it's small. If married, schedule a time to talk and pray about shared spiritual direction. If single, write down the spiritual qualities you will not compromise on in future relationships.
