**WALKING THE PLANK**

- Faithfulness Is Often Proven in the Seasons We Didn't Plan

- The Season May Be Longer for a Reason
- Faithful Doesn't Mean Easy

**RESPOND:** If you're ready to take a step, start here

- \_\_\_\_\_ I need to stop trying to control everything and start trusting God with the situation I'm facing
- \_\_\_\_\_ God is asking me to stay faithful in a season that has been longer or harder than I expected
- \_\_\_\_\_ I've been ready to give up or walk away from something God has called me to, and today I'm choosing to stay
- \_\_\_\_\_ I want to surrender my life to Jesus and trust Him not just for a moment, but for whatever long season He has ahead of me

**GROW:** Going Deeper for Personal Study and Application

- **Reflect:** Where in your life are you currently tempted to “*move on*” instead of remaining faithful? What pressures, frustrations, or disappointments make that season difficult right now? What might God be wanting to form in your character during this season?
- **Read & Pray:** Read through these passages this week and ask God to strengthen your faithfulness. [Acts 18:11–17](#) — Paul remains faithful in Corinth despite opposition. [Galatians 6:9](#) — God promises a harvest if we do not give up. [James 1:12](#) — God blesses those who endure testing. As you pray, ask the Lord to help you trust Him in the places where you feel pressure to give up or move on.
- **Take a Step:** Identify one area where God is asking you to remain faithful. Ask the Lord what the next step of obedience looks like in that situation. This week, take that step. Whether it's continuing to serve, continuing to pray, or continuing to trust God in the middle of the season you're in.
