### **BRINGING IT HOME**

- Stay Faithful as Surrender Moves Forward
- If You Haven't Started Yet...

**RESPOND:** If you're ready to take a step, start here

- \_\_\_\_\_ I'm recognizing where God is asking me to move from surrender into action, and I'm choosing to respond
- \_\_\_\_\_ God is showing me a need He wants me to step into, and I'm opening myself to serve
- \_\_\_\_\_ As I continue this fast, I'm asking God to keep me open and guide my next step
- \_\_\_\_\_ I'm choosing to trust Jesus with my obedience and let Him lead me forward

**GROW:** Going Deeper for Personal Study and Application

- **Reflect:** Where has God been inviting me to move from surrender into action? Are there needs I've started to notice but haven't yet responded to? What might obedience look like in a practical way right now?
- **Read & Pray:** Read [James 1:22-23](#) and [Romans 12:1](#) slowly. As you read, resist the urge to explain or excuse. Ask the Holy Spirit to help you see where listening needs to become obedience, and to give you grace to take the next step He's inviting you into.
- **Take a Step:** Choose one simple, concrete action this week that reflects obedience, not just intention. That may be serving, offering help, adjusting your schedule, or responding to a need God has brought into view. Don't wait to feel fully ready. Take the step you can, and trust God to meet you there!
