### Intro:

- Happy Mother's Day! Mothers, Grand-mothers, Spiritual Mothers, Spiritual Grandmothers ... We are amazed by you & are so thankful for you!
- When I think of my wife, the most amazing mother I know, I can't help but be amazed by her constant acts of service, and countless moments of sacrifice
- E.g. One day when she wasn't there! It was a disaster & I was exhausted!
- Ladies, we are amazed by you, your constant acts of service & countless moments of sacrifice
- I want to tell you, Jesus sees your sacrifice & he sees your servant heart
- Turn with me to Mark 12:41-44
- 6 Quick-Fire S's that He Sees!

### (1) He Sees Her Setting & Sacrifice (v41-42)

<sup>41</sup>Jesus sat down opposite the place where the offerings were put and watched the crowd putting their money into the temple treasury. Many rich people threw in large amounts. <sup>42</sup> But a poor widow came and put in two very small copper coins, worth only a few cents.

- o He Sees Her Setting: 'Jesus sat down ... and watched ... a poor widow'
- o He Sees Her Sacrifice: 'and watched ... a poor widow ... put in two very small copper coins'
- o E.g. Story of Nuns in an Irish Convent ☺
- o MTR: He Sees All Things: He Sees Your Setting & He Sees All Those Sacrifices

### (2) He Sees Her Soul & Servant-heart (v43-44a)

<sup>43</sup> Calling his disciples to him, Jesus said, "Truly I tell you, this poor widow has put more into the treasury than all the others. <sup>44</sup> They all gave out of their wealth; but she, out of her poverty, put in everything...

- o He Sees Her Soul: Cf. He knows man's hearts / Rich 'gave out of their wealth' / She out of her poverty, put in everything
- He Sees Her Servant-heart: Mark is presenting Jesus as the ultimate servant & portraying varying responses
  - In contrast to the rich & religious leaders who were serving self, this lady is a servant of God
  - E.g. Difference between a helper & a servant

### (3) He Sees Her Stewardship & Full Surrender (v44b)

but she, out of her poverty, put in everything—all she had to live on."

- How? How did she get to the place of servanthood? Stewardship!
  - Cf. context 4 stunning sections: You were made in God's image / You belong to God / You are Commanded to Love Him
    completely / Knowing Jesus is Declared to be Greater Than All
  - Mark is challenging his readers to steward all they have for King Jesus
- o And as a result he sees her full surrender
  - "all she had to live on"
  - E.g. Child in Donegal stepping into the basket here I am, I fully surrender

### HP: Jesus Sees Your Sacrifice, Servant-Heart & Full Surrender!

# CONTRASTS BETWEEN A HELPER AND A SERVANT

AHELPER	ASERVANT
<ul> <li>A helper helps others when it is convenient.</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>A servant serves others even when it is inconvenient.</li> </ul>
<ul> <li>A helper helps people that he or she likes.</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>A servant serves even people that he or she dislikes.</li> </ul>
• A helper helps when he or she enjoys the work.	<ul> <li>A servant serves even when he or she dislikes the work.</li> </ul>
<ul> <li>A helper helps with a view to obtaining personal satisfaction.</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>A servant serves even when he or she receives no personal satisfaction.</li> </ul>
<ul> <li>A helper helps when others notice, or there is public recognition.</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>A servant serves when no one notices, and there is no public recognition.</li> </ul>
A helper helps with an attitude of assisting another.	<ul> <li>A servant serves with an attitude of enabling another.</li> </ul>
