The Privilege & Priority of Prayer

Introduction:

- A// Good morning Fellowship what a privilege it is for me to be here today to share with you on the topic of prayer
- i. <u>Image</u> E.g. <u>Sponges</u> one keeps being soaked, so can keep being squeezed all day long. The other says I don't have time to be soaked, just squeeze me all day long. What's going to happen? Will get dry, hard, become useless.
- ii. Need Which one are you? If these sponges represent 2 types of Christians, and this bowl represents the intimate presence of God through prayer which one are you? I see a lot of people pouring themselves out, stretched & squeezed, saying I don't have time for this. And over time ACTIVITY FOR JESUS REPLACES INTIMACY WITH JESUS.
- iii. Need I was reflecting this week what is it that stops me going there?
 - a. <u>Busyness</u> // <u>Impoverished Africans</u> say you friends in the west have watches but we have time! // full time job, part time studies, full time dad so busy prayer life has become 'Lord, please help me today.' // <u>Perhaps that's you</u> as <u>individual</u>: So busy = prayer choked out; or <u>church</u> transitional moment all hands
 - b. <u>Belief</u> Somehow bought into very subtle lie, subconsciously, <u>I really don't need this</u> // E.g. <u>Corrie Ten Boom</u> our steering wheel of prayer has become our spare wheel only turn to it when our journey breaks down
- iv. Subject Today I want to call you back // COME BE SOAKED IN THE INTIMATE PRESENCE OF YOUR FATHER GOD

 THROUGH PRAYER. And I want to show you that in the life & ministry of Jesus, prayer was a privilege & priority. That even in the midst of incredible busyness, as he poured himself out as a servant, he had this deep belief prayer was a privilege which he was desperate to pursue and a priority which was desperately important to maintain.
- v. Text Mark 1:21-34.
- vi. <u>Preview</u> Watch out for how busy Jesus is pouring Himself out as a Servant, then Comes to be Soaked in the Intimate Presence of His Father through prayer

Read Mark 1:21-34

- Most action packed day in the life of Jesus, look at all the ways Jesus is busy pouring himself out
- I. Jesus Pours Himself Out As a Servant in Preaching & Driving out Demons (1:21-22, 23-27)
- ²¹ They went to Capernaum, and when the Sabbath came, Jesus went into the synagogue and began to teach. ²² The people were amazed at his teaching, because he taught them as one who had authority, not as the teachers of the law.
 - As soon as it was the Sabbath Euthuuus Immediately he went into the synagogue and began to teach
 - Amazed Struck with Shock and Awe
 - Authority (a) Experts (b) Enlightened (c) Explain (d) Elevated nothing on JC
- ²³ Just then a man in their synagogue who was possessed by an impure spirit cried out, ²⁴ "What do you want with us, Jesus of Nazareth? Have you come to destroy us? I know who you are—the Holy One of God!" ²⁵ "Be quiet!" said Jesus sternly. "Come out of him!" ²⁶ The impure spirit shook the man violently and came out of him with a shriek.
 - Immediately Euthuuus The presence of Jesus and the preaching of Jesus stir up demonic kickback
 - Unclean spirit Mark uses the terms unclean / evil / demonic spirit interchangeably synonymously
 - Hebrew Idiom What do we have to do with one another Why you meddling with us? You're on our patch!
 - Be muzzled muzzles that thing like a barking dog E.g. How many of you love dogs? More than your kids?
 - Drives him out and sets this man free With 1 command he silences the demon, with another he drives it out with supernatural authority and stunning servanthood he sets man free
 - This kind of lifestyle pouring yourself out greatest privilege on planet but can push you to limit exhausting
 - E.g. Me preaching passionate, pace, pour everything out, tears, put yourself in place of direct sp warfare
 - E.g. Me middle of night
 - MTR = If that's you, keep serving, but in order to stand you're going to need strength
- II. Jesus Pours Himself Out as a Servant Healing the Sick, Suffering & those with Strongholds (1:29-31)
- ²⁹ As soon as they left the synagogue, they went with James and John to the home of Simon and Andrew. ³⁰ Simon's mother-in-law was in bed with a fever, and they immediately told Jesus about her. ³¹ So he went to her, took her hand and helped her up. The fever left her and she began to wait on them.
 - As soon as / Immediately house of Simon Peter only a stone's throw from the synagogue (e.g. Stage Back)
 - Sick Fever, Luke tells us in ch 4 it was a high fever
 - Slammed on her bed [Matthew in ch 8 uses the word for 'to throw / to hurl']
 - SHE CAN'T GET TO HIM / HE GETS TO HER
 - Servant draws near to her, touches her [NET bible gently touches her], heals her of her sickness

[And as if the day can't get any longer ...]

³² That evening after sunset the people brought to Jesus all the sick and demon-possessed. ³³ The whole town gathered at the door, ³⁴ and Jesus healed many who had various diseases. He also drove out many demons, but he would not let the demons speak because they knew who he was.

- AFTER SUNSET Why did they wait? Sabbath sunset Fri Sat no travel / work! As soon as they can get to him!
- All the sick & Demon possessed literally all who were miserably ill / suffering
- Whole town gathered at the door why at the door? Couldn't get in maybe 5,6,7,8 rows deep perhaps 1000's
- This kind of lifestyle pouring yourself out greatest privilege on planet but can push you to limit / be exhausting
- MTR = If that's you keep serving, but in order to maintain this ministry you're going to need strength
- [[E.g. Dad middle of night phone rings I'll be there next morning exhausted falling into arms of Father]]

III. I'm Sure He was Tired - notice what happens next - He is Desperate to Run into the Place Where He is Soaked in the Intimate Presence of His Father through Prayer (1:35)

³⁵ Very early in the morning, while it was still dark, Jesus got up, left the house and went off to a solitary place, where he prayed.

- Very Early in the Morning NET = 4th watch of the night from 3am-6am
- While it was still Dark while it was still exceedingly nocturnal closer to 3am
- Jesus Got Up [to rise, sometimes to rise to meet someone]
- Left the House & Went Off to a Solitary Place wilderness place, same word used for temptation, same type
- Where he prayed PROS-WHO-OH-MY to praise & petition God in prayer Communion with the Creator

IV. Why? For Jesus - Prayer is a Privilege Place to Which He Loves to Run & In Which He Longs to Remain (1:36-38, 39)

- E.g. Superbowl Sun 2 months ago 2 tickets 50 yd line \$44,000 USD!! Access, Benefits Privilege, Count down
- This is how JC treats prayer greatest privilege of his life
- E.g. Hannah running into her Daddy's arms
- And Jesus knows the greatness of the Father, glory, goodness, grace he finds there.
- MTR = If you are bored, soul not stirred your view of God too small because this is an open invitation to
 commune with the creator, appointment with almighty, sit with your savior, rest in presence of ruler
- Sit at his feet, listen to his voice, to return to his will, rest in his promises, to be reinvigorated by his strength
- Spiritual Posture DESPERATE DESIRE For JC a phys. place he went to, more import. sp. posture he adopted

V. For Jesus - Prayer is a Prioritized Practice which Focuses Him on His Father's Will & Fills Him with His Father's Strength (1:36-38, 39)

³⁶ Simon & his companions went to look for him, ³⁷ & when they found him, they exclaimed: "Everyone is looking for you!" Jesus replied, "Let us go somewhere else—to the nearby villages—so I can preach there also. That is why I've come."

- Theology of Withdrawal JC withdraws 3 times in Mark to the place of prayer & each time he is under pressure
- Here v 36 Simon comes "Everyone is looking for you!" let's enjoy a day filled with fame and public acclaim
- Jesus = I'm not here to live for fame or public acclaim but for the glory of my Father's name
- In midst of temptation you need to stay true / flesh v follow / pressures of world v purposes and will.
- E.g. Dad's prayer
- Spiritual Posture FULL SURRENDER For JC he adopted this. sp. posture of full surrender in prayer focused

³⁹ So he traveled throughout Galilee, preaching in their synagogues and driving out demons.

- Having poured out his all as a servant, physically exhausted, he goes to prayer and he rises filled with strength
- Spiritual Posture TOTAL DEPENDENCE For JC he adopted this. sp. posture of total dependence filled
- E.g. Tony Evans 2 lumber jacks entered a tree cutting contest.

***HP - COME BE SOAKED IN THE INTIMATE PRESENCE OF YOUR FATHER GOD THROUGH PRAYER**

- With a posture of desperate desire, full surrender & total dependence COME, knowing Prayer = privilege & must once again become our greatest priority
- I know your leaders calling you to 40 days of prayer on Feb 26th, prayer in Life groups, prayer on Sundays
