- 5. What stands out to you most about the Magi's pursuit of Jesus, and how does their journey challenge the way we seek Christ today?
- 6. Herod pretended to want to worship Jesus while secretly planning harm. In what ways can spiritual hypocrisy still show up today, even subtly, in our own lives or churches?
- 7. The people of Jerusalem were disturbed along with Herod. Why do you think the arrival of the Messiah created anxiety rather than celebration for many?
- 8. Jesus offers us His faithfulness, His selflessness, and the greatest gift of all: everlasting life. Which of these aspects of His character do you feel most drawn to, or most challenged by, right now?
