PLAN A: A Life Of Isolation

1. The enemy’s plan is to **ISOLATE** you.

Be alert and of sober mind. Your enemy the devil prowls around like a roaring lion looking for someone to devour.

1 Peter 5:8, ESV

2. Isolation leads to being **SELFISH** thinking.

Whoever isolates himself seeks his own desire; he breaks out against all sound judgment.

Proverbs 18:1, ESV

3. Selfish thinking leads to **SIN**.

Who is wise and understanding among you? Let them show it by their good life, by deeds done in the humility that comes from wisdom. But if you harbor bitter envy and selfish ambition in your hearts, do not boast about it or deny the truth. Such “wisdom” does not come down from heaven but is earthly, unspiritual, demonic. For where you have envy and selfish ambition, there you find disorder and every evil practice.

James 3:14-16, NIV

PLAN B: A People Focused Life

Four Traits Of A People Focused Life

1. It was meant to be in **COMMUNITY**.

Then God said, “Let us make mankind in our image, in our likeness,...

Genesis 1:26a, NIV

2. It’s obedient in **LOVING PEOPLE**.

“Teacher, which is the greatest commandment in the Law?” Jesus replied: “‘Love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your mind.’ This is the first and greatest commandment. And the second is like it: ‘Love your neighbor as yourself.’ All the Law and the Prophets hang on these two commandments.”

Matthew 22:36-40, NIV

3. It seeks ways to **ENCOURAGE** others.

And let us consider how we may spur one another on toward love and good deeds, not giving up meeting together, as some are in the habit of doing, but encouraging one another—and all the more as you see the Day approaching.

Hebrew 10:24-25, NIV

4. It’s concerned about people’s **ETERNITY**.

For I am not ashamed of the gospel, because it is the power of God that brings salvation to everyone who believes: first to the Jew, then to the Gentile. For in the gospel the righteousness of God is revealed—a righteousness that is by faith from first to last, just as it is written: “The righteous will live by faith.”

Romans 1:16-17, NIV
