How God Gives Back More To Those Who Are Generous To Him

1. God gives us more FINANCIAL SECURITY.

Remember this: Whoever sows sparingly will also reap sparingly, and whoever sows generously will also reap generously. Each of you should give what you have decided in your heart to give, not reluctantly or under compulsion, for God loves a cheerful giver.

2. God gives us more PERSONAL SATISFACTION.

3. God gives us more CHARITABLE RESOURCES .

4. God gives us more ETERNAL IMPACT .
