

I. OUR FOUR DEEPEST HUMAN NEEDS

- 1. Our most basic need is PHYSICAL.
- 2. Our most dynamic need is **EMOTIONAL**.
- 3. Our most dependent need is **RELATIONAL**.
- 4. Our most foundational need is **SPIRITUAL**.

2. Care: He resolves inner emotional ANXIETIES.
